
LAS CRUCES PUBLIC ART: THE CITY OF LAS CRUCES PUBLIC ART PROGRAM

Highly-visible public art projects that assist with wayfinding and are deployed to welcome people to Las Cruces and guide locals and visitors to the City's distinct districts.




LANDMARK PUBLIC ART PROJECTS
