



S. _____, the *Tariff Refunds for Working Families Act*

U.S. Senator Martin Heinrich's (D-N.M.) S. _____, the *Tariff Refunds for Working Families Act*, establishes a tax rebate program for American consumers who have paid increased prices for everyday goods due to President Trump's illegal tariff policies.

Soon to be introduced, this legislation would establish the "Working Families Refund" using the billions of dollars in revenue generated by these tariffs and returning those funds to hardworking Americans. More specifically, this legislation would:

- Provide a tax rebate of \$600 to individual filers making \$90,000 or less.
- Provide a tax rebate of \$600 to head of household filers making \$120,000 or less.
- Provide a tax rebate of \$1,200 to joint filers making \$180,000 or less.
- Provide an additional tax rebate of \$600 for each dependent child.

Background

President Trump's tariffs have raised the cost of groceries and everyday essentials for Americans across the country. Even after the Supreme Court struck down key portions of his sweeping tariff actions, the administration has continued pursuing new tariffs, proving once again that he and his administration don't care about lowering costs for everyday Americans.

According to an analysis by the Yale Budget Lab, President Trump's tariffs have generated roughly \$195 billion in customs revenue, with a significant share of those costs passed directly on to consumers. The study estimates that the tariffs have contributed to approximately a 1.3–1.4% increase in core goods prices, as higher import costs work their way onto store shelves.
